#### REQUIREMENTS

According to the [CEC Screening Policy](#), the Routesetter positions are ranked “Level 2 - Medium Risk” positions. Therefore, the following requirements must be completed prior to performing the duties at the event:

1. Have a valid [2021-2022 CEC License](#) (athlete, coach, or officials license)
2. Provide an Enhanced Police Information Check (E-PIC) when invited to do so by CEC
3. Safe Sport & Ethics Training

  - b. [CAC Safe Sport Training](#)
4. Concussion Awareness training - [Making Head Way in Sport](#)
5. Return a signed copy of the [CEC Concussion Pre-Season Education Sheet](#)
6. Read and remain up to date on all CEC and IFSC rules and regulations.

The Head Routesetter is responsible for:

- planning, installation and maintenance of all boulders and/or routes
- communication and direction of routesetting team including Assistant Head Routesetter and all setters
- communication with Technical Delegate, Jury President and CEC Judges

- High level of personal organization

## **ASSISTANT HEAD ROUTESETTER**

### **JOB DESCRIPTION – ASSISTANT HEAD ROUTESETTER**

Under the direction of the Head Routesetter, the Assistant Head Routesetter is responsible for:

- planning, installation and maintenance of all boulders and/or routes
- communication and direction of setters
- communication with Technical Delegate, Jury President and CEC Judges

- Previous experience as Head Routesetter or Assistant Head Routesetter
- High level of personal organization
- Ability to work with a group in a high pressure environment

- IFSC accreditation (considered a bonus)
- Other national accreditation (USAC) (considered a bonus)

## COMPENSATION

The Head and Assistant Head setters are expected to be available as follows:

\*Head Routesetter is paid one (1) extra day for preparation prior to the event.

Compensation includes:

- Accommodation as booked and/or approved by the CEC Coordinator
  - o Successful candidates are expected to share a double occupancy room with another official of the same gender identification
- Food per diem (\$40/working day)
- Contract fee for the length of event as follows:

## SELECTION PROCESS

The selection committee for Head and Assistant Head Setter positions for the CEC Youth events is as follows:

- CEC Coordinator - Sebastian Powell
- CEC High Performance Director - Andrew Wilson
- Representative from host facility
- Members of the CEC competition committee

The selection committee will review all applications using the following criteria in order of importance:

### **First Priority Criteria – Head Routesetter**

1. International setting experience
  - a. IFSC Sanctioned events above the national level
2. National setting experience
  - a. Previous experience as Head Setter
  - b. 5 experiences as an Assistant Head Routesetter
3. Other competition experience, setting and competing
4. Knowledge of the Canadian competitive field

### **First Priority Criteria – Assistant Head Routesetter**

1. Potential for growth into the role of Head Routesetter in the near future

2. Setting experiences in the discipline being applied for
  - a. 2 setting experiences as a full setter at nationals or higher.
  - b. 2 setting experiences as Head Routesetter for a provincial level event.
3. Other competition experience, setting and competing.
4. Knowledge of the Canadian competitive field.

**Second Priority Criteria – both roles**

1. Knowledge of the current IFSC rules and regulations
2. Potential for growth as a Routesetter
3. Ability to mentor apprentice future Head Routesetters during the event (Head position)
4. Canadian Resident or Citizen, located in Canada
5. Proximity to the event host facility
